No one who experiences a critical incident or disaster is untouched by the experience. These events can threaten our sense of control and safety. Our trained and credentialed team assists individuals and groups in tapping into built in resiliency and returning to functioning.

What is the Kentucky Community Crisis Response Board?

Established in 1996 by KRS 36.250, the Kentucky Community Crisis Response Board is a state office created to recruit, train, and maintain a statewide credentialed Kentucky Community Crisis Response Team (KCCRT) of regional response-ready volunteers to provide psychological first aid and crisis intervention. The Team's mission is to promote resiliency in all citizens of the Commonwealth following a disaster or critical incident through pre-incident preparedness training and post-incident reduction of disabling stress.



Why should I consider joining?

"Being involved with KCCRT is a way to make a difference in a unique way by being a part of a team that helps others that are having trouble coping with challenging events."

"I have training and skills to be a compassionate presence during times of crisis. KCCRT gives me a chance to use those skills directly."
